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Frequently Asked Questions & Facts

Some things you might want to know about Bel-Mateo Babe Ruth Baseball:

- Bel-Mateo Babe Ruth is open to players age 13-15 (as of April 30th)
- **Babe Ruth's main goal is to prepare your player for High School Baseball – 90 foot bases!**
- Tryouts are open to any player age 13-15 who is not already on a Babe Ruth team.
- If you try out for Babe Ruth, you will make a team (unless you are a safety concern).
- If your player will be 13 and he wants to prepare for High School, then Babe Ruth Baseball is for him.
- For players not playing High School baseball, the games are broken up into two parts – the preseason games (starting early April) and the regular season games (beginning mid-May). During the preseason, the non-High School players get all the playing time and instruction, playing lots of baseball at lots of positions. High School players join for the regular season after High School baseball is over.
- Tryouts are in January, the draft is in February, practices start soon after.
- Babe Ruth managers have decades of experience playing and coaching baseball at all levels.
- Bel-Mateo Babe Ruth has many players you already know from Little League, as well as many players from all over the Peninsula that you will have the opportunity to play baseball with.
